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About us

The name 'Pragjyotishpur' connotes rays of primordial light and, in ancient times, signified the geographic area that spans much of what is Northeast **Bhārat** today. This name has been mentioned even in texts as old as the **Rāmāyaṇa** and the **Mahābhārata**.

Honouring the rich and vibrant legacy associated with this name, Pragjyotishpur University came into being on Monday, the 17th of October 2022, with the enactment of the Pragjyotishpur University Act No. XLVI of 2022 by the Government of Assam.

Pragjyotishpur University was founded with a resolve to nurture a center of world-class education and research driven by a cross-cutting approach for overcoming barriers to knowledge creation, sustenance, and dissemination. Each and every corner of this University rings with the rhythm of the true essence of **Jñāna** (knowledge), **Prajñā** (wisdom), and **Satya** (truth), three principles explicitly incorporated in the mandate of the National Education Policy (NEP, 2020). Pragjyotishpur University can accordingly be seen as a seat of learning born out of the National Education Policy (NEP, 2020).

The NEP, 2020 informs the direction of academic activities in the University, which formally began conducting classes at the Undergraduate level on Friday, the 1st of September 2023, for its maiden Academic Session of 2023-24. Heading into the Academic Session 2024-25, the University shall introduce Integrated Postgraduate Programmes as well under five Schools of Academic Excellence, and, with due approval from the Pharmacy Council of India (PCI), courses in the Pharmaceutical Sciences.

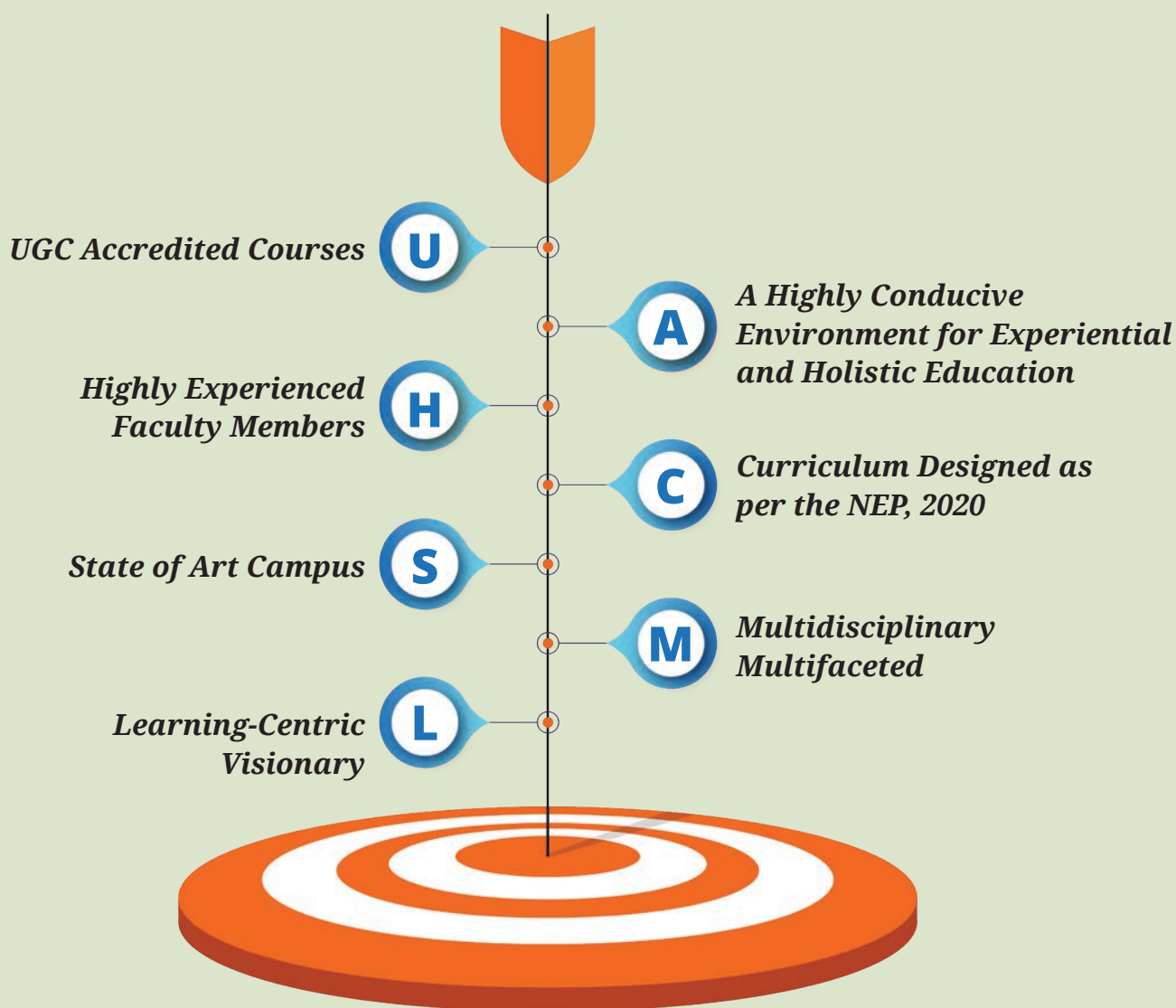

The Sponsoring Body: SERF



The Shankardev Education and Research Foundation (SERF) is a trust formally established on Sunday, the 22nd of August 2021, at Guwahati, Assam. It is a voluntary organisation that envisions quality higher education along with inculcation of the sense of **Bhāratīya** life values in students. The SERF aims to work on two fronts for realising its objectives:

1. developing educational institutions and
2. collaborating with educational institutions.

As a part of its first objective, Pragjyotishpur University has come into being with the enactment of the Pragjyotishpur University Act No. XLVI of 2022 by the Government of Assam. Today, the SERF is the sponsoring body of the University.

Immediately after its establishment, the SERF, taking a step towards its second objective, conducted a series of academic deliberations and knowledge dissemination exercises. The outcome was the Two-Day North-East Education Conclave 2021, which was organised during 20 & 21 November, 2021 at Guwahati Medical College & Hospital Auditorium and at Assam Administrative Staff College, Guwahati. The conclave aimed to illustrate the basic premise of NEP, 2020, its challenges, and experiences related to its implementation in some of the major states in **Bhārat**.

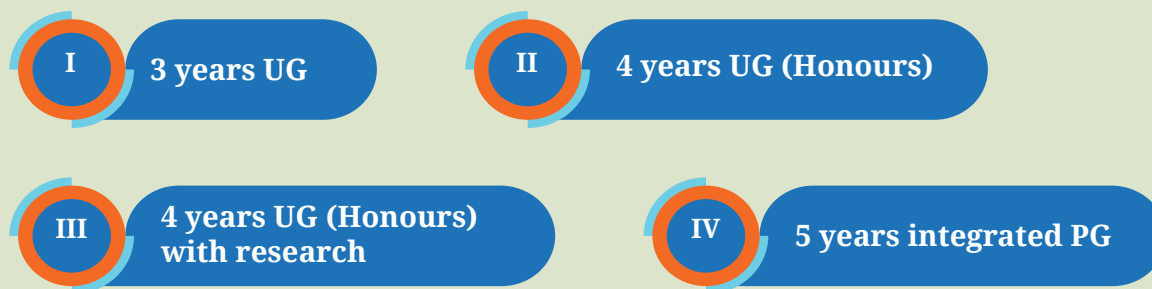
This was the biggest Education Conclave in Northeast **Bhārat** in recent years and was attended by many personalities of note: among them, the Hon'ble Chief Minister of Assam, Dr. Himanta Biswa Sarma; the Union Minister for Education, Skill Development and Entrepreneurship, Shri Dharmendra Pradhan; five education ministers from the states of Manipur, Sikkim, Arunachal Pradesh, Meghalaya, and Assam; representatives of the Education Ministers of Nagaland, Mizoram, and Tripura; and resource persons from various reputed organisations such as the AICTE, the NCERT, the NCTE, the UGC, IIMs, IITs, Central Universities, Colleges, and Schools.

Going ahead, the SERF organised the Pragjyotishpur Literature Festival, 2023, an extraordinary literary extravaganza held from 29 September to 1 October 2023 in Guwahati. The LitFest aimed at familiarising and bonding the people of **Bhārat** with the rich literary heritage of Northeast **Bhārat**. It also aimed at giving the youth of the region an occasion to tap into and become more aware of their own impressions regarding their roots in their cultures and literary traditions.

Credit

Each course offered shall carry a specified credit depending upon the quantum of work involved in the course. One credit of a course implies the quantum of work done corresponding to 1 hour of theory class or 2 hours of practical/field work or 4 hours of research every week during a semester.

Theory classes include classroom lectures and tutorials.

Credit points are calculated on the credits earned by a student and the level according to the National Credit Framework. The minimum requirement and the distribution of credits of the different modules of the undergraduate programmes are given in the following table:

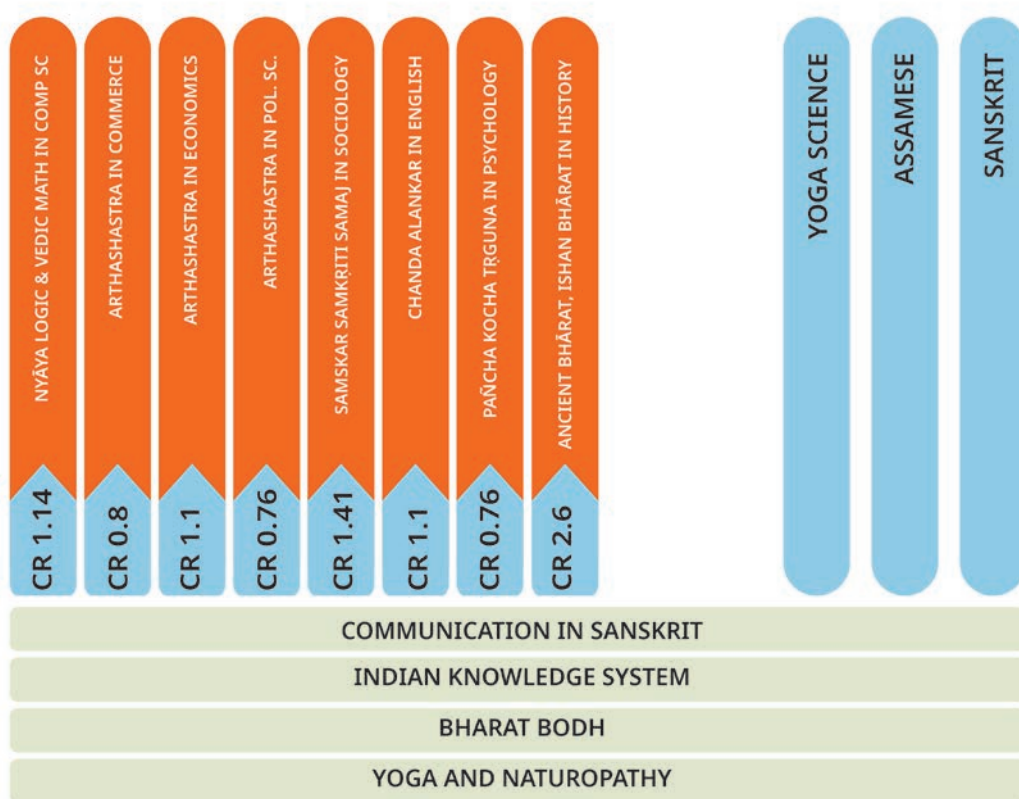

The implementation of IKS shall follow a horizontal-cum-vertical model in the curriculum: horizontal implementation of IKS will be in the form of introduction of subjects such as Bhārat Bodh; vertical implementation shall come through incorporation of units/topics across discipline-specific courses in a way that establishes connections between the present-day corpus of knowledge and its parallels in IKS.

Code of Conduct For Students

The Pragjyotishpur University (PU) Student Code of Conduct states, for the information of the University's students and staff (teaching/non-teaching), the standards of behaviour that students are expected to uphold. Prohibited Conduct

- Cheating, which is the intentional use of unauthorised sources of information and provision or receipt of unlawful assistance for any form of professional activity, including actions that are expressly forbidden by the teacher in the course syllabus or presentation.
- Plagiarism, which entails the unauthorized copying of someone else's language, structure, images, ideas, or thoughts and passing them off as one's own without due recognition, especially in the context of work that is being submitted for credit.
- Unauthorized possession or transfer of academic materials including unauthorized sale or acquisition of class notes, papers, or other academic materials.
- Assisting another individual in committing an act of academic misconduct.
- Verbally or physically abusing peers or staff.
- Committing acts of violence or endangering the physical well-being of individuals, including oneself, or animals, either through direct harm or by engaging in actions that could potentially cause bodily harm.
- Damage to institutional property or property of others.

- Involving oneself in conduct that interrupts or obstructs teaching, classroom dynamics, or any other educational engagements.
- Taking part in or promoting any demonstration, riot, or action that interferes with the normal operations of the university, limits the ability to move freely, or violates the rights of fellow members of the university community.
- Misuse or possession of alcohol or drugs.
- Utilization of substances leading to a state that jeopardizes the safety of oneself or others.

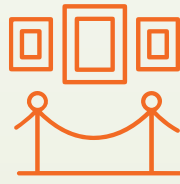
